School breaks up on Friday 16th December for the Christmas holidays and reopens on Tuesday 3rd January 2017.

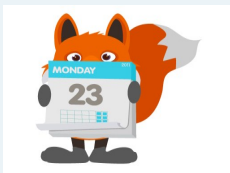
