How are the house teams organised?

- Every child from FS2 (Reception) to Year Six and every adult has been put into one of our four teams. Children are in the same teams as their brothers and sisters.
- Every team has two Year 6 House Captains. There are also two Vice Captains for each team. Vice Captains can be from any year group.
- Each house also has two adult House Leaders.
- Everyone has a coloured badge to remind you of which team they are in.
- Children will work in House Teams for various events such as Sports Day, competitions, fund raising events and more.

How do children earn house points?

Children can earn house points for lots of different reasons. This includes following our academy rules, being a Fox Hill Learner, following our academy vision of being respectful, ambitious and a good team player. Children can also win them for wearing correct uniform, remembering their PE kit and for being OTIS (On time in school).

What do children win?

Each week the House Captains will collect up the points for each team. The winning team will be announced in assembly. The winning team for the half term will win a prize or treat decided by the team. There will be an end of year prize for the overall winning team.

What do children do with house points?

When given a house point, it is the child's responsibility to keep it safe and to put it in the house tube in their classroom at the next available time. If they should lose their house point, this will not be replaced.

What are house meetings?

Each house will have regular meetings led by the House Leaders and House Captains. This will be an opportunity to talk about learning, how the team is doing, steps needed to earn more house points etc.
